With this in mind we are introducing a new communications system. The system will rely on emails and SMS alerts, depending on the nature of the communiqué. A dedicated email address or ID will be created soon, that will serve as the communication portal to and from APNS. Over a period of time we would want to do away with the practice of sending hard copies (printed material) from APNS and will like to encourage member publications and agencies to resort to same form of communication. We believe you will agree that this will assure a greater level of communication and speedier feedback.
